

Case Study: Natural Vegetation in India

Q.5. Case Study

Read the passage and answer the following questions.

India has different types of natural vegetation because of variations in climate, rainfall, soil, and landforms. Natural vegetation means plants that grow on their own without human help. In areas that receive heavy rainfall, such as the Western Ghats and parts of the North-East, dense forests grow. These forests are called tropical evergreen forests. Trees like teak, ebony, and bamboo are found here.

In regions with moderate rainfall, tropical deciduous forests grow. These forests shed their leaves in the dry season to save water. Trees such as sal, neem, and peepal are common here. In dry regions like Rajasthan, thorny shrubs and bushes grow. Cactus and babul are examples of thorn forests. In hilly and cold regions, coniferous forests grow. Trees like pine, fir, and deodar are found there.

Natural vegetation is very important for our environment. It provides oxygen, prevents soil erosion, gives shelter to animals, and helps in maintaining the balance of nature. Cutting forests leads to many problems such as floods, droughts, and loss of wildlife.





